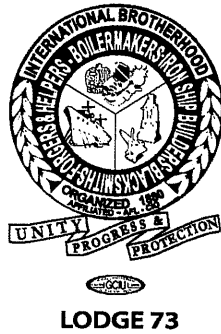

NB- Irving Oil  
LMC, Matrix – Were all sent home for 30 days March 20<sup>th</sup> due to COVID-19.  
Worley- Sent all non-essential staff home March 20<sup>th</sup> due to COVID-19.  
(11 Remaining with Worley)  
  
NB- IPP  
April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020- Still might be moving forward for small crew.  
  
NS- Nustar  
Bay Tank has sent 5 members home due to COVID-19 (4 Members left)  
  
NS- Woodside has sent 33 members home due to COVID-19  
  
ALL shutdowns scheduled during the COVID-19 pandemic have been postponed except the above mentioned.
- **Local 203**  
As of today, local 203 is at 100% unemployment.
- **Local 271**  
The Government has closed all non-essential jobs sites down. April 13<sup>th</sup> is tentative return date.
- **Local 128**  
Most sites have moved to a stand down due to COVID-19 some sites are in operation with essential staff only
- **Local 555**  
Most sites have shut down due to COVID-19 some sites are in operation with essential staff only.  
  
Huskey- looking at Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> start date for outage.  
  
Co-op looking at middle to late may for outage.

- **Local 146**  
Most sites have shut down due to COVID-19 some sites are in operation with essential staff only.

Shell Scotford- July 8<sup>th</sup> for 55 days tentatively.

Albian- July 8<sup>th</sup> & Aug 1<sup>st</sup> for tentative outages.
